After long break the *Expanded Media Section* of ULUS – the Association of Visual Artists of Serbia has again obtained the opportunity to organize regular annual exhibitions of the Sectio.

Before, the artists working in Expanded Media used to experiment with classical media aiming to remove borders between arts but also to make closer connections with other disciplines, with sciences, mathematics, and metaphysics particularly. Today, main experiments are digital: number of digital equipment is in use and powerful softwares are available. Yet most of these digital experiments stay in a way on the surface, usually they are reduced to press of icons, very rarely artists go deeper. That was the reason I chose the title SCRATCH DEEPER! Not to be misunderstood this exclamation is not addressed just to the artists but also to the public and even to the experts.

The exhibits are photographs, works on paper, installations, objects, videos, 3D animations. During the course of the show several live performances are planned to happen, as well as video presentations, cyber theatre, internet links... For the opening there will be performance of Jelena Koštica and concert of musical band XANAX (founded by Sana Garić, visual artist and poet). About events the public will be soon informed through media.
